MESSAGE TO MEMBERS

RESTRICTED ACCESS ORDER

FOR NORTHSIDE & SOUTHSIDE SUBDIVISIONS

BEGINS AT 6:00PM, SUNDAY, OCTOBER 03

In response to confirmation of COVID-19 cases in community, the growing number of COVID-19 cases in the region and the ongoing overload situation at the University Hospital of Northern BC, Chief and Council have issued a Restricted Access Order for the Northside and Southside Subdivisions.

Beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 03 access to the Northside and Southside Subdivisions will only be granted to residents, essential staff who are providing services and support to members and approved contractors who are working on LTFN projects. School buses will also be given access to transport students to and from school.

- Non-residents will not be granted access.
- TANO Fuels will also remain closed during this period.

Chief and Council have issued the Restricted Access Order for the purpose of ensuring the safety of members living in Northside and Southside. Prince George has one of the highest COVID-19 case numbers of any BC community for the past couple of weeks.

All Nations Security has been contracted to provide Safety Zones at the entrance to Northside and Southside. Residents, essential staff and approved contractors will be asked to sign-in and sign-out as they enter and exit the subdivisions. We ask that everyone to be courteous to All Nations Security staff during the Restricted Access period.

The Restricted Access Order will remain in place until Tuesday, October 12. Council and Administration will review the order and the COVID-19 situation at that time and adjust as required.

It is the community's responsibility to help keep everyone safe and we owe it to each other to continue to practice COVID-19 safety protocols.
