FISHERIES FOR LTFN MEMBERS



The Lheidli T'enneh First Nation (LTFN) Fisheries Department is pleased to report that there will likely be a Chinook opening this year for conservation purposes. It will be carried out by LTFN members. Stay tuned for additional information about the timing of this fishery.

We are very pleased to report is that there will be a Sockeye fishery starting Mon, August 09 for LTFN members between the Red Rock Canyon and the mouth of the Nechako River.Then on Wednesday, August 11, a 2nd Sockeye fishery for Lheidli members will take place between the mouth of the Nechako and Isle Pierre.

Fisheries Manager Dominic 'Domo' Frederick will monitor both fisheries to ensure that only LTFN members take part. Members will be required to produce proof of membership if requested.

A Culture Camp will be held at the Health Center to process salmon caught in these fisheries. Again, more information will be available closer to the date of the event. Please ensure you use the right equipment to participate in these fisheries and always be safe.
