MESSAGE TO MEMBERS NO PERMISSION TO HUNT IN LHEIDLI TERRITORY

Chief and Council have made the difficult decision to close this year's hunting season again this year in Lheidli Territory to support increasing populations of moose and other ungulates.

This is the 5th year we are not issuing permission to hunt letters in Lheidli Territory.

Chief and Council is aware that one of the methods to support increasing moose and other ungulate populations is to not hunt.

They are also aware that forest and land management plans also must change. Chief and Council and Administration are working with resource users in Lheidli Territory to make changes including improved conservation, that also support increasing moose and other ungulate populations.

Improved conservation will help ensure that traditional food such as moose and other ungulates will be available for future generations of Lheidli T'enneh.
