CHIEF LOGAN HELPS REOPEN THE EXPLORATION PLACE

Chief Dolleen Logan gathered with community and local government leaders to reopen The Exploration Place. The popular innovation and science centre and museum has been closed since March 2020 initially as a precaution to stop the spread of Covid-19 but more recently to allow for upgrades and new exhibits and features. Everyone attending the Sneak Preview event said the 'Wow Factor' of the new features and upgrades was awesome.







In an interview with CBC Radio after the ribbon-cutting Chief Logan talked about the special partnership the Lheidli T'enneh First Nation has enjoyed for over 20 years. She said that her nation has trusted The Exploration Place with its story and some of its most cherished historical artifacts and that it is a partnership model that could be adopted by other First Nations. Chief Logan also spoke about the partnerships between her nation and the City of Prince George and the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George which also span 20+ years. **The Exploration Place reopens to the public on Saturday, October 29!**
