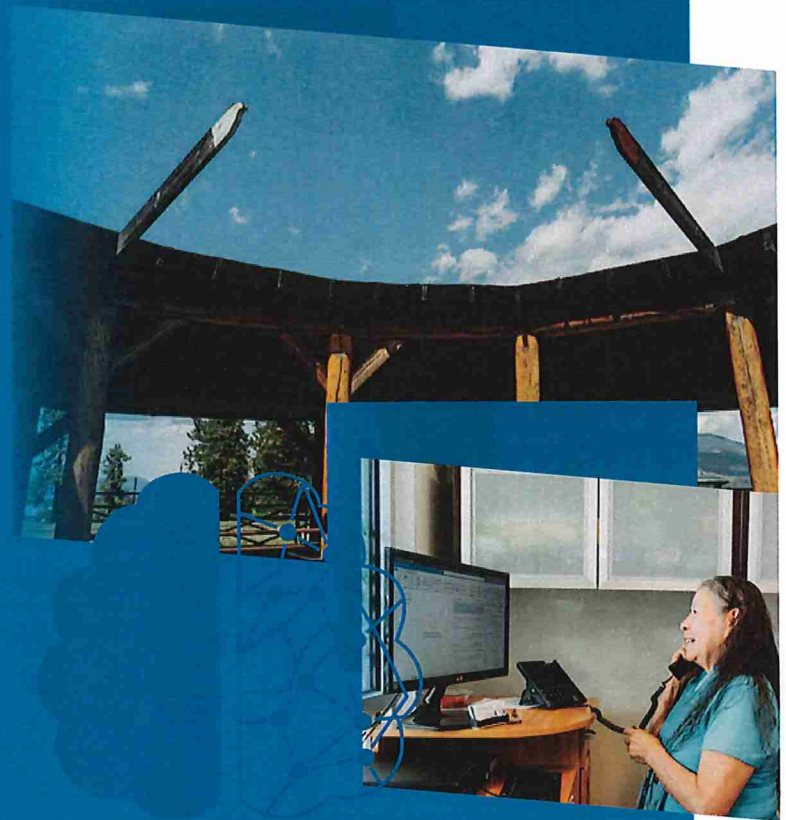
Introduction to Computers in Today's World is an introductory-level training program designed for Indigenous learners who want to deepen their knowledge of computers in the modern world.
