ANNUAL FLOOD WATCH UNDERWAY & REMINDER OF 'NO BURNING' ON RESERVE

Administration wishes to inform members that our Annual Flood Watch for both the North and Southside is now underway.

Administration also wishes to remind members living in the North and Southside neighbourhoods that there is '**no burning**' on reserve lands.

Administration has activated the LTFN Emergency Planning Committee (EPC) which will meet weekly during the Annual Flood Season and regularly during the Summer Fire Season. Executive Director Joe Gosnell is Chair of the EPC.

Councillor Wendy Jael and Doug Olson are the official Flood Watchers for the Southside while Duncan Seymour is the official Flood Watcher for the Northside. All will observe water levels in the Fraser River several times a day and communicate regularly with Joe.

The EPC will ensure that sandbags are prepared and ready to be deployed if required. The EPC has also been in contact with Emergency Management BC (EMBC) to access Tiger Dams if required during the Flood Season.

The EPC will also review the current Evacuation Plans for the North and Southside for both the Annual Flood and Fire Seasons. Once the plans have been reviewed, information will be shared with members in both neighbourhoods.

Members are encouraged to keep a safe distance from rivers, streams, and creeks in the territory during the Annual Flood Season and especially, during the upcoming Victoria Day Weekend.

Members are asked to visit the LTFN Main Facebook Page and Website Messages to Members on a regular basis for information updates.
